

### **Foxley to Weston Longville (8 miles, 20 minutes)**

Turn right from the A1067 in Morton on the Hill. No sign. Car park on left just before church.

### **Weston Longville to Honingham (4 miles, 10 minutes)**

The church isn't in the village but to the north of the A47. Just after the A47 roundabout there's a lay-by with white posts marking it. Park there or in the churchyard immediately after, through the gate. There's a turning area on the right at the top of the drive so best not to park in that as there's only one way in and out.

### **Honingham to Wymondham (8 miles, 20 minutes)**

Turning right onto the A47 from the churchyard might be difficult and take ages so unless it happens to be convenient it will be better (and quicker) to turn left and go via Marlingford. Parking on the roads around the Abbey, some of it restricted to an hour. There's also a little car park at the bottom of the hill near the railway. If you have to use a town centre car park you might need to go round the one way system.

### **Abbey to lunch pub (1 mile)**

Turn right onto Church Street and right onto Damgate Street (one way). Left onto London Road and right onto Station Road at traffic lights.

### **Pub to Hethersett (5 miles, 10 minutes)**

Church is on the right on the B1172 (Norwich Road). Car park is through a gate on the right.

### **Hethersett to Ketteringham (2 miles, 8 minutes)**

Left from the church, left to Ketteringham on Ketteringham Lane, right at junction towards Wymondham, left onto Church Road. Go through the stone gateway to the hall (marked 'private'). It's OK to go through the gate but not to use the big car park. After going through the gate turn right onto the new gravel track to the parking area at the east end of the church.

### **Ketteringham to Saxlingham Nethergate (10 miles, 20 minutes)**

We can leave the Ketteringham estate by turning right from the car park via the other road marked private. The Worlds End pub is on the right on entering Mulbarton. The ford near Shotesham Park is a nice one with a depth marker if you fancy going that way. Church car park is up a lane at the conical tree.

### **Foxley to Fakenham (10 miles, 20 minutes)**

Follow the red route on the map. Park in Tesco car park, down a slope on the right before the market place. 3 hours free parking.

### **Dereham**

Should be plenty of on street parking near the church at that time.

### **Foxley to Swanton Morley (5 miles, 10 minutes)**

Car park on the left just below church, at bowling club.

### **Swanton Morley to Elmham (5 miles, 10 minutes)**

Parking at side of road on the left opposite church, more a bit further on, on the right at the village sign. There are two pubs, The Railway and The King's Head. There's also a tea room at the Post Office, on the left on the way back to the crossroads. Not sure if it will be open. Also a shop where you can get supplies for a picnic in the chapel gardens if it's a nice day.

### **Elmham to Gressenhall (4 miles, 10 minutes)**

Church is not in village, but about half a mile to the south west. Big parking area at church. No toilets here. Nearest toilet opportunity on the way home is probably Waitrose at Swaffham, just off the A47.
