

Three pubs in Cavendish, Bull Inn, The George, Five Bells. All open at 12:00 noon.

In Clare there are a number of pubs, cafés, and tea rooms including one in the old station at Clare Castle Country Park. There is a coffee morning in the church until 12:00 noon.

For the tea break there is The Bell Inn in St James Street, Castle Hedingham and in Sudbury there are several pubs near the church including Wetherspoons. There are also a few tea rooms but many close at 4:00pm. Marimba in Borehamgate at the junction of Great Eastern Road and King Street specialises in hot chocolate but also does other refreshments. They close at 5:00pm.

Café Viva in King Street beside the church is a café and pizza establishment which closes at 8:00pm and posh Huffers nearby closes at 6:00pm.

There are places where you can eat, or get refreshments in Ixworth;

The Greyhound, High Street. 01359 230 887 – homely cooking and a warm welcome, comfortable, pool darts etc. Colin and Sue have run the Greyhound for over thirty years and I have no doubt in recommending their warm welcome.

The Pykkerell, High Street. 01359 230 398 – more traditionally beamed, ex-coaching inn.

This is a splendid inn and the food is reasonable, although I have found that the restaurant service has not always met my expectations.

Theobalds Restaurant, High Street, approximately opposite Greyhound. 01359 231 707 – highly acclaimed by many. I have not eaten here but have spoken to those who can recommend it.
